CASE STORY – SOWMYA

Introduction:

Sowmya, was born on March 14th, 1995, at her residence without the need for any medical intervention. Her father was Mr. V. S Thimmaiah, Her Mother, Mrs. Savithri, and her younger brother is Mr. Rajesh.

Background:

- There were no issues during her birth, however, when Sowmya reached the age of one, her parents noticed a delay in her developmental milestones and observed that her head size was smaller than expected. The doctor diagnosed the condition as Microcephaly, which is the underdevelopment of the brain. Unfortunately, the doctor informed Sowmya's parents that there was no cure but they should provide exceptional care to the child. There were no cases of Microcephaly in their family and therefore, remain unaware of the specific cause behind their daughter's condition.
- Mrs. Jamila, a staff member at CHIC, provided Sowmya's parents with information about the Centre. Interestingly, Jamila's own daughters are
 also studying at CHIC. Recognizing the potential benefits for Sowmya, the headmaster Mr. Shivraj, visited their home to assess Soumya after
 which, her parents decided to enrol her at CHIC.
- The recent death of her Father has affected Soumya a lot emotionally and she seemed very disturbed.

Interventions provided:

- Education: Sowmya is granted the opportunity to access education and recreational opportunities at CHIC without any financial burden. She
 can attend classes, learn from dedicated teachers, socialize with the other students and engage in various educational activities provided by
 the school according to her capacity.
- Transportation Facilities: CHIC offers transportation services free of charge. So she is able to travel safely, eliminating any concerns about commuting.
- Food: Milk, egg and lunch are provided every day so her nutrition is catered to.
- Medical Care: Sowmya benefits from the expertise of Dr. Abhimanyu Chandak, a psychiatrist who provides specialized treatment and the school provides the medication. Regular health check-ups are held.
- Regular Dental Check-ups: The dental staff at Coorg Institute of Dental Sciences, Virajpet, conduct routine check-ups for Sowmya. These
 check-ups contribute to her oral health and hygiene.
- Physically Handicapped Pension After ensuring that she has received her UDID card, application for pension was made and she receives Rs. 1400/- the Physically Handicapped Pension – a social security scheme from the Government.
- Uniforms: Uniforms have been provided to the students.

Progress Monitoring:

As part of progress monitoring, significant improvements have been observed in Sowmya's overall well-being and behaviour since her enrolment at the school. The following changes have been noted:

- Enhanced Recognition: Initially, Sowmya had difficulty identifying objects and individuals. However, she has made remarkable progress and can now recognize and distinguish people both at home and at school, indicating a notable improvement in her cognitive abilities.
- Improved Emotional Control: Sowmya used to exhibit anger and frustration by throwing objects, expressing herself through gestures rather than vocalization. Although she still experiences moments of anger, her temper levels have decreased. Additionally, she demonstrates a faster ability to calm down.
- Eating Habits: Sowmya often displayed reluctance to consume meals, and forcing her would provoke anger. However, efforts are made to provide a variety of appealing foods and create a positive mealtime environment to encourage her interest in eating.
- Affinity for Children: Sowmya has a fondness for children and takes care of them. She displays a nurturing attitude and willingly assists
 others by collecting fallen beads or toys and escorting others. This inclination toward helping others reflects her growing social skills and
 sense of responsibility.
- Toilet Independence: Initially, she faced challenges in using the toilet independently. However, she has made notable progress in this area & manages her toileting needs.
- Comprehension of Spoken Words: Sowmya has made significant strides in her language comprehension. She now exhibits an increased
 understanding of verbal instructions and conversations initiated by others, indicating advancements in her receptive language skills. She has
 started tearing paper for the handmade paper unit and using the Peg board under the guidance of Headmaster Shivaraj which are recent
 marked changes noticed.
- Co-curricular activities : She has slowly learnt painting, to participate in yoga. Sowmya possesses a genuine love for music, so when she
 witnesses others dancing, she can't help but join in the rhythmic movements.
- Sowmya's fondness for visual stimulation is evident as she spends extended periods watching television. Similarly, her eyes light up with
 curiosity and wonder when exploring the vibrant images found within the pages of books, allowing her imagination to soar. These diverse
 interests provide Sowmya with avenues for self-expression, social interaction, and sensory exploration, contributing to her overall happiness
 and engagement with the world around her.

Intentions for the Future:

- Goal of Independence: There is a specific plan in place to empower Sowmya to perform basic tasks independently. This objective focuses on fostering her self-reliance and increasing her ability to complete daily activities with minimal assistance.
- Dedicated Team: Everyone at CHIC, are committed to supporting Sowmya's progress. Their combined efforts create a supportive environment where her growth and betterment are prioritized.

CASE STORY - ASIM. T. A

Introduction:

Asim, was born on January 1st, 1990 at home. He experienced slow developmental milestones during his childhood. His father, Mr. Ali, works as a labourer, and his mother Mrs. Ayesha stays at home. Asim has seven siblings.

The family received information about Cheshire Homes India Coorg from their close friends and relatives and then both he and Sadik were enrolled.

Background:

Asim's parents were made aware of his stagnant brain growth as he was diagnosed with intellectual disability at NIMHANS- Bangalore.
 Despite attending a government school in Nelliahudikeri upto the 7th grade, he couldn't progress further. Asim's mother, Ayesha, also has an intellectual disability, with four of her children.

Interventions Provided:

- Van Facilities: Cheshire Homes India Coorg offers free van facilities for students to commute to the Centre.
- Uniforms: Asim, along with other students, receives uniforms provided by Cheshire Homes India Coorg.
- Pension: Recognizing the challenges faced by individuals with disabilities, Cheshire Homes India Coorg assisted Asim to avail the UDID Card and the Physically Handicapped pension, a social security scheme of the Government, to support their financial well-being. This regular financial assistance helps ensure a certain level of stability and independence.
- Health: Promoting holistic healthcare, CHIC organizes regular dental check-ups in association with Coorg Institute of Dental Sciences for individuals with disabilities. Regular health check-ups are also held.
- Vocational Activities: CHIC offers vocational activities that enable individuals like Asim to develop skills and engage in meaningful work.
- Sports Participation: Recognizing the importance of physical activity and recreation, CHIC encourages individuals including Asim, to
 actively participate in sports. This inclusive approach promotes physical fitness, enhances social interaction, and boosts self-confidence
 among the beneficiaries.
- Food: Milk, egg and lunch are provided every day so they get nutritious food. Asim loves non-vegetarian food which is provided regularly.

Progress Monitoring:

- 1) Academic Skills:
- Numeracy: Asim successfully writes numbers without making errors.
- Literacy: Asim demonstrates proficiency in writing alphabets and is able to identify and write his school and home address.
- Drawing Skills: Asim shows some drawing abilities.
- Colour Recognition: Asim is able to recognize different colours accurately.
- Time Concept: Asim has acquired the skill to read time.
- 2) Practical Skills
- Household Products: Asim has learned to make phenyl, liquid soap, and paper bags. He participates actively in the manufacture of Handmade paper.
- Gardening Assistance: Asim assists in gardening activities, indicating a developing understanding of gardening techniques and practices.

3) Extracurricular Activities:

- Playtime: Asim enjoys his playtime and actively engages in recreational activities.
- Cultural Activities: Asim participates in various cultural activities, contributing to his overall personal and social development.
- Sports Achievements: Asim has earned gold medals in games, highlighting his exceptional performance and skills in sports. He also participates in yoga in school.

By monitoring Asim's progress across these areas, we can observe his development and identify areas where further support or challenges may be necessary.

Parent's Outlook:

• The parents have a strong desire for Asim to become independent and venture into entrepreneurship. Their hope is for Asim to open a small shop where he can manage his own business and earn a livelihood.

Intentions for the Future:

The teachers express satisfaction with Asim's consistent attendance, meticulous completion of tasks, and his ability to bring required materials to school. They appreciate his level of independence and hope that he maintains these positive traits. They also share the parents' aspiration for Asim to develop the skills necessary to manage a small business and lead an independent life. The teachers are committed to providing guidance and support to help Asim acquire the

Through its 2 Community Based Rehabilitation Programmes by JOAC -UK, from 2003 - 2006 and by the Big Lottery Fund -UK - from April 2006 to 2011, CHIC worked in 38 villages with over 950 Persons with Disability, their caregivers and various stake holders. This programme was recognized by United Nations as "Best Practices for including persons with Disabilities in all aspects of development efforts"

The activities from August 2021 to July 2022 are mentioned as follows:

One of CHIC's primary objectives is to provide comprehensive rehabilitation and medical support to individuals with disabilities. The organization offers state-of-the-art facilities equipped with cutting-edge technology and a team of dedicated professionals. CHIC ensures that each individual receives personalized care tailored to their unique needs.

Health:

- Dental camps were conducted every month by Coorg Institute of Dental Sciences, Virajpet, with Dr. Chandru, Dr. Sareena, Dr. Niveditha, Dr.Krishna Leela, Dr Supreeta & Nurses
- On the 28th October student Prajwal had convulsions so he was given first aid and shifted to Pollibetta hospital. As he did not show any improvement he was later shifted to Madikeri Government hospital for further treatment. He has recovered now.
- On the 13th November the Lions Club of Pollibetta, Iksha Speciality Eye Hospital & Cheshire Homes India Coorg conducted a very successful Eye camp. Over 180 people were treated, Some of them were referred for further treatment and surgeries to Dr. A.G Chinnappa's Iksha Hospital Madikeri.

We are grateful to Dr. Chinnappa who buys our handmade paper bags every month for use in his hospital.

- Psychiatrist Dr. Abhimanyu Chandak visits regularly to examine our students in the presence of their parents.
- Medicines prescribed by him are distributed monthly to the students suffering from epilepsy.
